Adopt-a-Block

The Human Concerns Committees of our tri-parish cluster are cooperating on an Adopt-a-Block Team, which is a part of the Faith-Based Organizations (FBO) within District 4 of the Milwaukee Police Department (MPD). The FBO consists of different religious and community organizations who dedicate time to building safe and healthy neighborhoods. Volunteers from each parish will meet at 105th Street and Mill Road at 11:00AM for an hour on an assigned Saturday several times a year, the first one being November 14. The group will be accompanied by two MPD officers who are community liaisons. After a brief prayer, litter will be picked up along 104th and 105th Streets, and flyers offering community resources will be placed on doors.

The choirs of St. Bernadette, St. Catherine of Alexandria and Our Lady of Good Hope, along with composer, Jeffrey Honoré and an instrumental ensemble, will join forces for this hymn festival. Jeffrey Honoré will serve as the narrator for this festival of song and the spoken word.

The hymn festival will take us on a journey through the Church's liturgical year, featuring the music of Jeffrey Honoré, a well known Milwaukee composer.



Jeffrey Honoré is Director of Music Ministry at Holy Apostles, New Berlin, WI. Since 1994, Jeff has also served as Director of the Milwaukee Archdiocesan Choir. Previous positions were Pastoral Musician/Liturgist at St. Benedict, Fontana, WI., Director of Liturgical Music at St. Matthias, Milwaukee and Director of Liturgy & Music at Christ the King, Mesa, AZ while also serving as the Diocesan Chorale Organist, and even earlier as Minister of Music, along with his wife Debra, at St. Anthony of Padua, Milwaukee. Jeff and Deb have been married for 35 years and continue to work together as keyboard partners for concerts and special events.

Since the late '80s Jeff has been active as an arranger/composer of liturgical music for choirs, organ and handbells through many publishers. Since the late '90s Jeff has also served as a handbell clinician specializing in the use of handbells in worship.

Jeff and Deb have three sons and one grandson, born this past summer. Look for Jeff on the golf course, or hiking with his wife, during the summer months in Wisconsin!
