Recap

The strategic planning process kicked off in October, and with the commitment and help of parishioner volunteers, parish staff members, and resources from the Archdiocese, we are making great progress!

In January...

- A roadmap was developed mapping the three phases of the project.
- Purpose, scope, and organization of the process were developed.
- A Steering Committee and workgroups were formed.
- Interviews with parishioners across all demographics began.
- A project charter* and project plan* were developed.

In February...

- The interview process is nearing completion.
- Interview data is estimated to be compiled by early March.
- Workgroups are accumulating data on existing programs and ministries.
- Data from the census surveys is being finalized.
- A strategic planning web page is in development to increase our ability to communicate throughout the process.

Looking ahead...

Our next steps will include analyzing the data from the interviews, the workgroup research, and the census surveys. In March and April, the Steering Committee and workgroups will work from the data to identify opportunities and make recommendations. **The vision of a vibrant Catholic presence in Northwest Milwaukee remains our guiding light and be assured that we will be communicating every step of the way as our process unfolds.** Thank you for keeping our parishes in your prayers.
